ENGINEERING EDUCATION PROGRAMME... The Isuzu Group has organised a special automotive engineering education programme in conjunction with the King Mongkut Institute of Technology Lat Krabang (KMITL), a statement from the company said.

The programme included technical lectures, for which Isuzu had donated diesel engines as educational material, the statement said.
